Directors Meeting
Minutes
April 18, 2010

The line up for events on Sunday has been changed to Office will open at 7AM Rodeo Begins at 9AM with Poles, Cal Stake, Team Roping, Steer Stopping, Steer Daubing, Barrels, Tie Down Roping, Breakaway, Ribbon Roping, Dummy Roping will begin at the same time as Calf Stake Tying, Calf Tracking, Chute Dogging and Goats. It was Moved and 2nd to accept the daily line up

Rick made a motion that Team Ropers in the Draw pot must be paid and checked in by 9:00 AM to be in draw IF NOT THEY WILL NOT BE IN THE DRAW! 2nd by Tom Amendment by Tom to change the time to 9:30 instead of 9AM. The Rule will read as If a member is in the Draw pot Team roping they need to check in and pay the office by 9:30AM and be paid to be in the draw pot. If not checked in and paid by 9:30 AM they will not be in the draw!!!

New Business, John Suggested we have a high Money Header/Heeler buckle Roping for the Slippery Gulch Days in June with the club purchasing the buckles. Jacki made a motion and Steve seconded, Passed

Rick made a motion to have a breakaway, calf roping and Team roping this same weekend as the Slippery Gulch days with the breakaway starting at 2PM and calf roping to follow and Team Roping to follow approximately 6pm. Tom Seconded. Passed.

Rick made a motion to stick with on stock contractor for Team Roping, Steve seconded. Bobby suggested it should be sent out for bid, After much discussion and representation from one contractor Kris would bring her steers for \$45 per steer a month. She has a total of 32 steers available. Becky made a motion Kris bring 32 head if we don't need that many she will break down what is needed. Becky withdrew her motion. John Moved to use Kris as the stock contractor for all 4 rodeos \$45/per steer 32 steers if there is a small roping will prorate what is needed. Death loss in contract. Passed. Kris's brother will be calf stock contractor for Breakaway calves with 10 calves being used. Becky made motion to use Kezie's goats for all four shows 2010 Passed.

LaDeen Made a motion to strike out the \$1.00per event awards charge due to the new \$25/\$50 sponsorship fee.

Other new business brought up Kris will donate 100lbs of hamburger for a raffle. To be raffled off at the August Rodeo. Tickets will be \$1.00 per ticket or \$5.00 for 6 tickets. Tickets will be sold by members. Passed!

Rick Fredrickson made a motion to pay the insurance for the year, Scott seconded. Passed!

Kris made a motion that if a member no shows, un-notified a \$25.00 plus entry fee is to be charge to that member. Toni seconded. Passed

Refrigerator at the Colfax Rodeo Grounds belongs to the PRRA and needs to be moved to the Tekoa. Kurt will look into getting it moved?

Rick made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 3:25PM
